



As a new driver your main concern may not include how to park a car straight, but it is still a necessary skill to learn. You can impress your friends with your near perfect parallel parking skills. If you are a person who likes to pay attention to detail, parking right compared to other cars next to you in the parking lot will give you some satisfaction. Remember that perfecting your driving and parking skills takes time and a lot of practice. Queue your car by car directly in front of the open space. Your rear bumper should line up with him. Pay attention to the front end of your car to make sure that you don't risk coming into contact with the car in front of you — if you are, start over from the first step. Move backwards until the sides of your car line up with the sidewalk. You can open the door to check the sidewalk or just measure how the side of your car is lined up with the car in front of you, assuming that it has been parked straight as well. Approach the open parking lot slowly. Just as you reach the car next to the place where you want to park, turn your wheels in the opposite direction from the place (left if the parking lot is on the right, and vice versa if it is on the left) so that your car moves outwards. This will allow you more space to park directly to the premises. Make sure no one comes from the opposite direction before you perform this maneuver. Pull your wheels back into the free space once the front bumper goes about two feet past the first line marking the spot and keep rolling slowly. Use lines as your guideline to stay straight. Drive to the parking lot be careful not to connect with other parked cars. You will know that you are straight if your front bumper easily enters a place with a large space between both sides of your car and two other parked cars.
